Business Tips



Printer Tip:

Be ready for your printer/copier service call - you may find it a bit shocking. We had a client just last week call in for service on an all-in-one machine, only to find out it was \$95.00 just to diagnose the problem!

Make sure you ask **first** how much it is for the initial service call, and if that amount goes towards the repair. We have recently heard that infamous line again, "Using remanufactured cartridges will void your printer's warranty". You just speak up and say, "NOT TRUE". Even better, it's because of an act of Congress!

It's the same act that says you can get your car's oil changed with any brand of oil you like. And don't forget that most remanufactured cartridges contain up to 40% more toner than new - this means you get many more copies and that saves you money!

Recycling tip: Reduce the amount of junk mail you receive at home and at the office by contacting the [National Do Not Mail List](#), and other free services to have your name removed from mailing lists.
